

YOUR DOG & VISITORS: 5 TIPS TO PREVENT TROUBLE

Visitor Etiquette

Put dog on leash, & hold leash when you open door Practice every time guest arrives or mail is delivered Correct for bark, growl, jump, AND teach a better way to act





Place Training

"Place" is a spot the dog goes to, to settle down
Put a "place" mat near your door & ask dog to wait
there when visitors arrive, like the mailman

Embrace the Crate

If you're not home, your dog is safest in a crate or outdoor kennel It prevents harm to themself or others, destruction, and escaping It helps them feel safe & relaxed





Socialize to World

Teach dog to be comfortable in the world

Take to pet-friendly places & ask to exist calmly

Don't pressure to interact with people. Instead, teach to
be neutral about people.

Ask for Help

If your dog explodes, lunges, hides, growls, or barks a lot around people, find a trainer to help you! Doing so helps your dog find peace in their life, keeps people safe, and keeps your dog safe.
